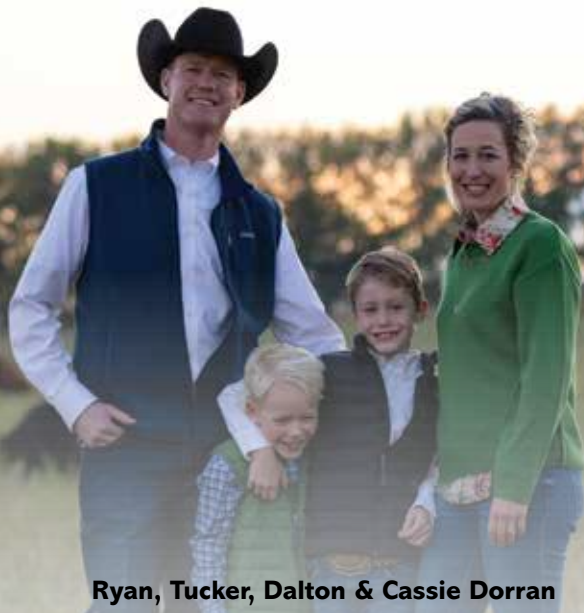

## Terms

The terms of the sale are cash, cheque, wire or e-transfer, payable on location or within 15 days following the sale to Dorran Cattle Co. The right of property shall not be exchanged until after satisfactory settlement has been made. Every group will sell to the highest bidder times the number of head in the lot; the auctioneer will handle any disputes if needed. Announcements from the auction block take precedence over printed or previously announced details. All monies are in Canadian funds.

## Viewing

Summer evenings are a great time to come view the heifers on pasture. Call/text Ryan at 403-507-6483 to stop by for a visit! On the afternoon of sale day, heifers will be penned by sale lots at the barn.

## Pregnancy/Health Verified

Dr. Waylon Wise, DVM, at CCHMS performed ultrasound pregnancy examinations on all heifers. A 283-day gestation table was used based off the natural service observation in combination with the dated ultrasound verification. Heifers have been on native pasture since the first of June and had free choice salt and mineral.

## USA Buyers

We welcome U.S. customers. Transportation as well as health and export paper fees would be the responsibility of the buyer. Dorran Cattle Co. will help with arrangements. Contact Ryan before the sale for more information. Current U.S./Canadian exchange rate would put Americans at a significant advantage paying around \$7,300 USD for every \$10,000 CAD bid.

## Transportation

Buyers are responsible for all transportation of sale purchases. We kindly ask that heifers are at their new homes by the last week in September. Dorran Cattle Co. may be able to provide some guidance and help to line up transportation arrangements if needed.
